Main Functions of the Post:

1. To plan, implement and evaluate programmes of care and education for children under 5 in the playzone and nursery environment, in accordance with the Pre-Birth to Three Curriculum and the Jeely pedagogy.
2. To set up the pre 5 stay and play/nursery in accordance with the curriculum and children's care plans.
3. To support parents and carers in their role as primary carers.
4. To contribute to the evaluation of service provision.

Main Duties:

1. To work in a non-judgemental way and to respect confidentiality of service-users.
2. To participate in the planning, implementation and evaluation of programmes of care and education for children under 3, in accordance with the curriculum and National Practice Model Getting It Right for Every Child.
3. To participate in the planning, implementation and evaluation of home support programmes for families in response to specific, identified needs
4. To ensure that all equipment is maintained in accordance with health and safety policies and procedures.
5. To provide one to one support to children, parents/carers in response to their needs as agreed with senior staff.
6. To participate in a multi-agency approach to service provision

7. To arrange for the delivery and setting out of equipment/supplies required for outreach programmes.
8. To become conversant with the policies and procedures of the Jeely Piece Club, and to implement these in everyday practice
9. To attend such meetings and training sessions as may be deemed necessary by the managers of the Jeely Piece Club
10. To contribute to the production of publicity materials and assist in campaigns to publicise JPC services
11. Support and supervise sessional workers, volunteers and students.
12. To undertake such other relevant duties as may be required from time to time by senior staff members.
